The Courtside Junior Tour is a program that offers players a chance to compete in a match/tournament-play format each week. Players will attend sessions in a three-hour time period each week and be placed into a round robin or tournament-style format. Each week players will earn points and receive a ranking based on their performance.

**We have made some changes for the 2009–2010 season:**

The changes to the Junior Tour include the implementation of the new Tencap system. Tencap will allow players to view results and ranking information, results, and trends against other players on the web. For more information regarding Tencap, check them out on the web at [www.tencaptennis.com](http://www.tencaptennis.com).

**Some other changes include:**

- In the new format of play, the intermediate and advanced players will now have the chance to play both full sets as well as the tie breakers played in previous seasons.
- This season's Junior Tour will be held on Saturdays and Sundays to allow more court time for the new format. Players eligible for set play will receive a schedule of play in the Saturday "Tournament," which will be held from 3–6 pm, beginning in the first week of the season.
- With Courtside's new Tencap system, players will be able to view regularly updated tournament and tour results online at all times. Each week as the results are computed, players will also receive updated Tencap ratings and trending rankings, as well as watch their point totals relative to other players.
- Using the Tencap system, players will also be able to see their results against other players on their level, how they are trending in their match performances, and communicate with other players in the club using the Tencap networking system.
